Central European News is a small British news agency specializing in weird stories that often fill up your Facebook feed — but are also often wrong. If you’ve read about the Russian fisherman whose Justin Bieber ringtone scared away a bear or the man in China who got a tapeworm from too much sashimi, you’ve encountered a story from CEN. A BuzzFeed News investigation takes a deep dive into the agency’s questionable practices and found that only 9 of 41 CEN pieces evaluated appeared to be real or mostly real.
