

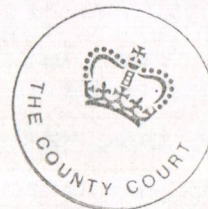

The Court ordered that the Respondent MS Manuela Odette Silva be forbidden (whether by instructing, encouraging or permitting any other person)

1. To engage in conduct capable of causing nuisance or annoyance, (including but not limited to causing noise nuisance, shouting and arguing, playing music or her TV at an excessive volume) to any person who resides, visits, or engages in lawful activity of Campden Houses, Peel Street, London, W8 7PJ.

2. To engage in conduct capable of causing harassment, alarm or distress to any person who resides, visits or engages in lawful activity of Campden Houses, Peel Street, London, W8 7PJ or Fox Primary School, Kensington Place W8 7PP.

3. This order shall remain in force until 4pm on 25 May 2024 unless before then it is revoked by further order of the court. Any party affected by this Order may apply to the Court to vary or discharge it.

4. It is further ordered that the Respondent do pay the Applicant's costs of this application assessed in the sum of £ 895.00
