Dear All,

Just to say that Ana Maria's father will be bringing her to Vienna next week, possibly on Friday 9 Feb, and I will arrange accommodation here before sending them on somehow to Innsbruck.

The following is the plan.

Early next week. I need to send a letter to her parents just to confirm for the border guards why she is coming here, should there be any problems, with my details and contact numbers on the letter.

Thursday - Family set off from Roman - Both parents and Ana Maria.

Arrival Friday or Saturday - Stay in Vienna - Sunday head off to Innsbruck

Monday, 12 February, Anamaria starts with a course of treatment at the hospital. Total time 5 days. Returns by train probably Saturday to Vienna, and from here back to Roman.
